

## **FOUR PERISH FROM EXPOSURE IN FOG WRECK**

**LONDON, Sunday.**

Four men died of exposure and three others are missing after the 411-ton trawler Leicester City went aground in dense fog yesterday.

The other 12 members of the crew have been saved.

The vessel went aground off Breibuster Reef in Hoy Sound, off the western entrance of Scapa Flow.

Fifteen members of the crew of the Dutch ship Spaarnstroom spent a frightening hour in dense fog in the English Channel on Friday night after their ship had collided with the German vessel Waldemar Selg.

After drifting all night with only the stern section afloat, the Spaarnstroom was taken in tow by the Dutch ship Stentor which also picked up the missing sixteenth crew member.
